Annie Christie

I was born in Epsom, Surrey and we emigrated to New Zealand in the 60s. I'm proudly a 10 pound Pom! I was brought up in a strongly Christian environment, very much a part of Baptist Church happenings. My mother was deeply involved in supporting overseas missionaries in India and Pakistan, particularly Tripura and Brahmanbaria, and also led a children's mission group called Ropeholders, which I helped with. We attended Easter camps annually, and as a teenager I responded to an altar call at a Youth Camp at Elsdon, and was baptised after that. I joined the Interschool Christian Fellowship at Heretaunga College, and became a camp leader, mentored by Margaret Peapell who was influential in my Christian journey, as was the minister Roy Bullen.

I have worked in education for nigh on 45 years, teaching all levels, with management roles in many different schools both in New Zealand and overseas in England, Oregon, Minnesota and Vanuatu. With the introduction of online university study, I completed my Master of Education in 2007. Values have emerged as a strong focus in schools, and I like to make them the centre of our learning. In my spare time I enjoy book club, writing bios for Hospice patients, tutoring Scottish Country Dancing, and being a celebrant.

I have been married to Quentin, a retired photographer, for 17 years. I have two grown up children, Selina and Adam, and three beautiful granddaughters – Lily, Ivy and Willow (my botanicals!), plus four step-grandchildren in Scotland.

There was a period of time when I drifted away from the church, letting other things take over, dealing with loss, grief and personal issues. In searching for answers and peace, I slowly realised what was missing and that I needed to reprioritise, commit and trust that God was still with me and had a plan for me.

I'm passionate about the Missions we are involved in. I am grateful that the Parish enabled me to lead the Kids Connecting Mission with Vanuatu, and participate in the supporting Christian women in Myanmar Mission. These involved trips to Vanuatu and Myanmar, and I learnt so much from the people – people with not a lot materially, but with so much love, kindness and spirituality.
