Bonhoeffer

Bonhoeffer remains one of most influential theologians of last century. His book "The Cost of Discipleship" is a contemporary Christian classic. This movie tells of the influences of his home life on his faith; his growing opposition to the Nazi regime, and his willingness to die for his beliefs and the true Germany he envisaged. Bonhoeffer was killed a few days before World War II ended, because of the outspokenness towards Hitler's war that ran contrary to his Christian beliefs.

Watch this from the comfort of the church lounge chairs. There will be afternoon tea served at "interval" as it is a long movie (almost 3 hours).
