Today's celebration of World Leprosy Day is a timely reminder that the aim of a leprosy-free world by 2036 is now less than 10 years away. Although the incidence of leprosy has steadily declined in recent years, pockets of it remain around the world. If treated early enough, leprosy can be completely cured by medication, leaving no visible scars. Sadly, because of the stigma attached to the disease, early symptoms are often covered up, and sufferers hidden away, making it difficult for them to be found when a free Leprosy Clinic visits their village.
